HSS4324 C TRANSDISCIPLINARY COMMUNITY HEALTH ENGAGEMENT

Students who wish to apply for registration to HSS4324C in Fall / Winter 2009 - 2010 must complete the attached form and return it to the Academic Secretariat at MNT232 before **July 31, 2009**.

This course is limited to 28 students. Travel and accommodation cost for practicum outside of Ottawa will be covered by the university.

Student selection and placement will be determined by the co-ordinator responsible for the Faculty of Health Sciences Transdisciplinary Community Health Program [FHS TCHP] in collaboration with the course professor. Confirmation of registration will be given as of **August 14, 2009**. During the selection process students may be contacted by e-mail by the co-ordinator.

Course Dates

Preparation classes: Between September and December 2009, five 3-hour preparatory modules will be held. These five modules make up the 15 hours of compulsory theory for the course and will be held in POR 106. The modules will be held on September 11, September 18, September 25, October 30 and November 20, 2009.

Community health Experiences: Forty-five hours of practicum experience is required and will be scheduled in collaboration with placement agencies. Practicum hours must be completed between **September 2009** and **March 2010**.

Practicum sites in Ottawa and outside of Ottawa will be arranged depending on student enrollment and agency requirements. Some placement experiences may occur as one or more solid blocks of immersion experience.

Seminars: 2 seminars will be scheduled during the winter session 2010. One will be held on January 22, 2010 and the last seminar will be held on March 12, 2010. The final seminar will be an opportunity for students' to present, debrief about their experiences and evaluate their participation.
